GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Parish Live streaming and radio facilities from Westport will continue.
- Please do not participate in congregational singing at this time.
- There are two pods for the congregation, for the bottom section please enter via Mall door, for top section James St. door. No crossing between sections.
- Church doors will open 30 minutes before the start of Mass. PLEASE COME ON TIME
- Newsletters may be collected as you LEAVE the church.
- There will be no offertory baskets, boxes will continue to be left in church for envelopes.
- Please insofar as possible attend the toilet before leaving home.
- Please wear a mask while in church.
- Anybody who is feeling unwell with flu like symptoms should not attend Mass.
- Please follow instructions for Holy Communion, coming forward in your pod as instructed, by the centre or by the side wall, returning in each case by the pillars.
- Please receive Communion only in the hand.
- Please do not leave at Communion time and wait until instructed to do so at the end of Mass.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Correspondence from the Taoiseach's office makes it clear that events such as Holy Communion and Confirmation can take place from Monday July 5th. Therefore all First Holy Communions already booked from July 11th to August 15th will go ahead unless families have made alternative plans since booking. Please note the following:

- Families who have booked for June 20th, June 27th & July 4th WILL BE CONTACTED BY THE PARISH IN ORDER OF DAYS ALREADY BOOKED from this Wednesday June 9th.
- There will be four extra spaces made available in the Trancepts for these children each Sunday from July 11th to August 15th.
- There will be space for up to 14 children still available for August 22nd.
- Any family who has booked a date from July 11th to August 15th and now wants to change, should email before Wednesday June 9th at 9:00am. and will be contacted by the Parish from later that day the same as above.
