HAITI EARTHQUAKE

The devastating earthquake which hit Haiti has killed around 2,000 people and left many others devastated. The tropical storms which have followed them and are ongoing have added to the devastation. Many of us are aware of the wonderful work done by local woman Gena Heraty is on the ground in Haiti and doing wonderful work. I have been in contact with Gena and thank God she is well, she is on the north of the island and the worst effected area is in the south. The families of many of her co-workers are caught up in the devastation and she is trying to help them. If anybody would like to support the people of Haiti at this time you are welcome to place an envelope marked 'Haiti' in any of the collection boxes in the church or in the Presbytery during the coming week and it will be passed on directly to Gena. No doubt many of you are supporting her through other avenues, please continue to do that, this is simply offering an opportunity to anyone else who would like to help. Gena has asked that we pass on her love and gratitude to you all for your support.

ACCESS TO OUR CHURCHES

During lockdown a service was provided to the country churches whereby the Mass was streamed outdoors to cars via the public address systems. Now that the churches have reopened we are strongly encouraging a return to community and ask that the churches be full to current capacity before these systems are turned on. The inside of our churches are safe and we encourage you in.

Regarding Westport church the opposite problem has emerged and we apologise to those who have been left outside and unable to access Mass and Holy Communion. When the church is full the James Street door will remain open, those who have to stand outside should do so at safe distance and Holy Communion will be distributed. Hopefully this situation will ease as the summer draws to a close.

BAPTISMS

At the moment we are operating a system where we are facilitating individual Baptisms in order to keep people safe. However we will eventually go back to a system where there will be two Baptisms together and we will revert to the usual system of Baptisms every Sunday, except on the second weekend of the month where Baptisms take place on Saturday, however we continue to clear the backlog.
