#### **SACRAMENTS FOR THOSE WHO ARE CRITICALLY ILL**

A central part of the ministry of the Parish continues to be ministry to those who are critically ill and in danger of death. The priests continue to make these personally at the invitation of close family. In order to protect both the families, all parishioners and the clergy, clear protocols are being followed. In the case of nursing homes this has already been established and is working well. In the case of visits to private homes where someone is gravely ill, the priest will first meet the family outside the home, where the family may stand in the doorway and the priest will remain outside (Don't worry about the weather) for a chat with the family. The family will take the priest inside following the chat and attend to the person who is ill, returning immediately outside before continuing to chat to and support the family any way he can.

#### **BAPTISMS**

**Where Baptisms take place, there should only be the child for Baptism, two parents/guardians, and two sponsors, preferably all from the same household.**
