St. Mary's Church Westport - St. Patricks Church Lecanvey – St. Mary's Church Drummin

In Line with Civil and Church Guidelines – the following is now being implemented in this Parish until further notice.

- Mass will take place each morning at 10:00am Sunday – Saturday. This Mass will be behind closed doors but will be broadcast live on Parish Radio 104.8 FM. And Facebook.
 - The intentions for each days Masses will be offered at 10:00am on that day, Intentions for Drummin & Lecanvey will be offered on Saturday mornings.
 - The church in Westport will open at 10:30am daily until 8:00pm.
 - All other churches in the Parish will be open daily but there will be no Mass celebrated.
 - Baptisms are not taking place except in emergencies.
 - Funerals are taking place on a 'Private Family only' basis and in accordance with HSE guidelines.
 - Parish buildings are no longer available for meetings until further notice.
 - The church currently meets social distancing requirements, please comply with social distancing requirements.
 - Please use sanitizer provided on entering and leaving the church and try to avoid touching surfaces.
 - If lighting candles in the church please use the gloves provided and dispose of in the bin provided immediately and sanitize hands.
- As the situation is fluid we will update you as soon as information becomes available.
